StoryMaps Criteria:

- Must be shared publicly
- StoryMap should take no longer than 10 minutes to read through
- Mobile-friendly formatting is preferred
- Story Maps must include submitters name(s), organization, and category track in the Coverpage of the StoryMap

- Analytic
- Project
- Student/Academic
- Other

How to Submit:

- Submit your StoryMap at <https://expo.gisforum.org/poster-registration/>
 - Note: StoryMaps may be updated using the SAME link until August 22, 2022. Final Versions MUST be updated by this date, August 22, 2022.
- Be sure to fill out all fields including: StoryMap Track/Category, Brief Description, and the URL

1. StoryMaps will be displayed on a laptop/screen in the Hall Area of the Convention Center, where the Poster Contest used to be held. StoryMaps will also be uploaded to an HUB Site accessible by QR Code for Mobile Viewing
